ordered by the Court that Information be Exhibited by Mr Joseph Francis Clerk of the Indulgents ag^t the said David Cole for committing the Fornication &c &c

H. His Lord Ship Kent County in Maryland & Be it Remembered that on the third day of Sep. 1731 William Choram of Kent County & promise Labourer Servant to George Gleaves of the same County Wheelwright and John Heating of the same place planter and John Gleaves of the same place wheelwright personally came before me the Sub Sheriff one of the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord prop^{ty}s Justices of the peace for the County aforesaid and Acknowledged to owe unto the said Right Hon^{ble} the Lord prop^{ty} viz. — the said John Heating and John Gleaves Ten pounds Sterling each good & Lawfull Money of Great Brittain of their goods & Chattels Separately to be made & Levied for the use of his said Lord Ship his heirs and Successors if Default be made in the condition under written

The condition of this Recognizance is Such that if the above named William Choram. do and personally before his Lord Ships Justice at Chester
