Recognizance to be void otherwise to stand as before said in full  
force and virtue at Law

At which said next Court to wit at Hon<sup>ble</sup> County at the Court house in  
the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday in June being the  
seventeenth day of June Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and  
thirty three came the afo<sup>re</sup> Mary Bryan and in her proper person  
appeared and prayed the afo<sup>re</sup> Recognizance might be discharged.  
Ordered by this Court here that the afo<sup>re</sup> Recognizance be  
discharged Laughlin Bryan recognizance taken in the sum  
of twenty pounds Sterling money is by this Court here discharged there  
being no cause shown to the contrary.
