Ordered by this Court here that John Gresham Esquire Sheriff of said County keep the aforesaid Thomas Kesson in safe custody until the fine aforesaid shall be paid and thereupon he be committed

Ordered by this Court here that John Gresham Esquire Sheriff of said County keep the aforesaid Thomas Kesson in safe custody until the fine aforesaid shall be satisfied and thereupon he be committed

Ordered by this Court That John Gresham Esquire Sheriff of Kent County keep Thomas Kesson in safe custody until he shall give good Security for his appearance at next Court to be hold for said County on the third Tuesday in March ensuing and in the mean time to be of good behaviour

Thereupon the said Thomas Kesson of Kent County Taylor person in Court in his proper person cognate and acknowledges himself indebted to the Right Hon. the Lord Proprietary of the Province of Maryland in the sum of Twenty pounds Sterling money of Great Brittain to be made and levied on his body goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors conditionally that if he the said Thomas shall not make his personal appearance at the next Court to be hold for said County on the third Tuesday in March then next ensuing and in the mean time he is to be of good behaviour wherewith the said Thomas acknowledges himself content

and also at the same time came Henry Trulock of Kent County Planter and Henry Barber of Kent County Labourer in their proper person acknowledge themselves indebted to the Right Hon. the Lord Proprietary of the Province of Maryland in the sum of Ten pounds Sterling each to be made and levied on their bodies goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors conditionally that if the aforesaid Thomas Kesson shall not make his personal appearance at the next Court to be hold for Kent County on the third Tuesday in March then next ensuing and in the mean time he the said Thomas Kesson is to be of good behaviour wherewith the aforesaid Henry Trulock and Henry Barber acknowledge themselves to be therewith content
