of the said Lord Proprietarie that now is his good Rule and Government and against the
form of the Act of Assembly in that case made and provided. It shall be

And the afo^r Elizabethe Simmonds in her proper person comes and saith that she cannot
gainsay the Indictment and so as and against her brought up but that she is guilty of the
punishment upon her imposed as it is by the afo^r Indictment alledged And therupon Submits
to the Court. Wherefore it is Considered by the Court here by all the Court House in
the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday in June being the Seventeenth day of
said Month anno Domini Seventeen hundred twenty nine That the afo^r Elizabethe Simmonds
pay the sum of Thirty Shillings Current money for her fine for Committing the said act and
also to pay the sum of two hundred twenty one pounds of Tobacco Cess arising on the
premises app to the officers of this Court.
