Hon^{ble} County of the Jurors for the right Honourable the Lord Proprietors that now is for the body of Kent County of upon their Oath do profess that Andrew Norwell late of Shrewsbury Parish in the County of Weaver the tenth day of October Anno Domini Seventeen hundred twenty and nine with force and arms at the Parish afo^r in the County afo^r within the Jurisdiction of the Court one file of the value of twelve pounds of Tobacco of the goods and Chattels of a certain Daniel Greenwood then and there being found upon and there felonously did steal take and bear away contrary to the peace of the said Lord Proprietors that now in his good rule and Government and against the form of the Act of Assembly in such Case lately made and provided Tell your Book Humphrey Younger

under oath the same bill was as told Bella Vera y^e the Attorney for the said Andrew Norwell in his proper person cometh and saith that he is not in no sort guilty of the premises above upon him imposed as by the said Indictment it is alleged and thereof he putteth himself upon the Country Andrew Norwell in p^rson

Of which said precept the said Sheriff to wit Joseph Young Gent was here at this day to wit the third day of November being the eighth day of said month Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and twenty and nine and makes return that he hath here ready twelve de. as by his precept he was Commanded And now here afterwards to wit the day and year last mentioned came against the said Elphinstone by his Attorney as the said Andrew Norwell in his proper person and the Jurors of that Jury being summoned and called likewise came to wit William Woodland Charles Smith Thomas Bradley Edward Rogers Jun^r. Morgan Hunt William Deane Samuel Gooding John Macey John Clayton Joseph Hill John Browning Daniel Tozant who being duly charged and sworn to say the truth in the premises upon their Oath do say that the said Andrew Norwell is guilty of the felony as he stands indicted and by William Woodland therefor man all to say Therefore it is considered by the Justice here all the Court House in the Town of Chester in said County on the third day of November being the eighth day of said month Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and twenty and nine that the said Andrew Norwell stand in the pillory one quarter of an hour and that afterwards he receive at the publick whipping post five lashes with said on his bare back till the blood appear as a punishment for his said Crime of felony according to the force form and effect of the verdict afo^r as also pay the sum of two Shillings current money being the four fold of the file afo^r be paid to the said Daniel Greenwood as also i
