Wilson Memorial Methodist Episcopal Church, South, Incor., the sum of Twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000); To the Board of Missions of the Methodist Episcopal Church, South, a body corporate, for the use and benefit of the building known as Hayes Wilkens Bible School, located at Sungkiang, China, the sum of Twenty-five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00); To the Trustees of the Central Methodist Church South, a body corporate, the sum of One thousand dollars (\$1,000).
