

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency law and necesary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, and the same being passed upon a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, shall take effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 16.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the Commissioners of Delmar, Wicomico County, Maryland, to issue bonds in an amount not exceeding the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00), to provide for the construction, extension, maintenance and operation of sewerage and storm-water drainage systems; to provide for the levy of taxes, assessments and benefits, charges and rates, for the payment of said bonds, and the operation, maintenance, regulation and control of said systems; to provide for the condemnation of property and to provide penalties for the violation of the provisions of this Act.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That for the purpose of providing funds for the designing, construction, establishment, condemnation, maintenance and operation of the sewerage and storm-water drainage systems in the Town of Delmar, Wicomico County, Maryland, the Commissioners of Delmar be, and they are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to issue bonds from time to time in such amounts as may be deemed necessary to carry on the said work, but at no time shall the total amount of such bonds exceed the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00); said bonds shall be either registered or coupon bonds, issued in such denominations as shall be determined by the Commissioners of Delmar by ordinance; shall bear interest not exceeding five per cent. per annum, payable semi-annually, and shall be serial type bonds and shall mature in not exceeding fifty years from the date of issue, and shall be forever exempt from State, County and municipal taxation. Said bonds shall be signed by the President of the Commissioners of Delmar, with the seal of the town of Delmar attached thereto, attested by the Clerk of the said Commissioners of Delmar, and if coupon bonds, the coupons thereof shall be signed by the Clerk of the Commissioners of Delmar or a fac-simile of his signature shall be engraved or printed thereon. Said bonds, when signed and attested as heretofore directed, shall be delivered to the Treas-
