

land, and E. Frank Kelly, shall severally continue as such until their membership be terminated by death, resignation or removal. And any member may be removed for cause by a two-thirds vote of all the members; provided that any member so removed be first furnished with a copy of the ground of removal and be given an opportunity to make answer thereto. Upon the occurrence of a vacancy in the membership, it shall be the duty of the remaining members to elect by ballot within one year after the occurrence of a vacancy some one to fill such vacancy.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1929.
