(e) To the Safe Deposit and Trust Company of Baltimore, the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500) in trust, the net income arising therefrom to be used for the use of the Sunday School connected with the Centenary Methodist Episcopal Church, Westminster, Maryland.

To the bequests contained in the last will and testament of Maria Louise Reifsnider Creecy, deceased, said will being probated by the Orphans' Court for Carroll County on October 14, 1930, and recorded in the office of the Register of Wills for said county in Wills Liber W. F. B. No. 13, folio 590, as follows:
