

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That a new section be and it is hereby added to Article 2 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Anne Arundel County," sub-title "Justices of the Peace and Constables," said new section to be known as Section 368A, to follow immediately after Section 368 of said Article and to read as follows:

368A. The County Commissioners of Anne Arundel County are hereby authorized and empowered to pay a salary of forty dollars (\$40.00) a month to the Justice of the Peace in the first precinct of the Fifth Election District; the said salary to be paid in lieu of all fees in criminal cases and said Justice shall return to the County Commissioners of Anne Arundel County, all fines, penalties, forfeitures and costs imposed by him and which he shall receive for or on account of criminal offenders tried before him under the provisions of the Code of Public General Laws and the Code of Public Local Laws.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1931.

## CHAPTER 90.

AN ACT to add 18 new sections to Article 23 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Wicomico County," to be under sub-title "Hebron," said new sections to be known as Sections 94A to 94R, both inclusive, and to follow immediately after Section 94 of said Article, to incorporate the town of Hebron, in Wicomico County, Maryland.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That 18 new sections be and they are hereby added to Article 23 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Wicomico County," and to be under sub-title "Hebron," said new sections to be known as Sections 94A to 94R, both inclusive, to follow immediately after Section 94 of said Article, and to read as follows:
