

SEC. 4. *And be it further enacted,* That the said interest coupons and said bonds shall be payable at the office of the County Treasurer of Wicomico County and whenever such coupon or coupons, bond or bonds shall have been paid or redeemed, it or they shall be cancelled or destroyed by the County Treasurer and note thereof made on record of said bond.

SEC. 5. *And be it further enacted,* That the County Commissioners of Wicomico County, Maryland, shall advertise the said bonds in at least two newspapers published in Wicomico County, and one newspaper published in Baltimore City, and by such other advertisement as may to them seem proper and advisable, inviting sealed proposals for the purchase of said bonds, with the privilege to the said County Commissioners of Wicomico County to reject any and all bids, and no bid shall be accepted at less than par; the said County Commissioners shall advertise said bonds for such length of time as to them may seem adequate, and shall offer all of said bonds at the same time; and no part of the money arising from the sale of said bonds shall be used except for the purpose designated and provided for in this Act; provided that costs of engraving or printing said bonds and the costs of advertising authorized by this Act and the other incidental expenses connected with the issuance of said bonds, may be paid out of said funds.

SEC. 6. *And be it further enacted,* That after the payment of expenses provided for in Section 5 hereof, the money arising from the sale of said bonds shall be paid over to the Treasurer of Wicomico County and credited by him to the County Commissioners of Wicomico County and to be used by said Commissioners to pay all of the outstanding scrip in the form of interest bearing notes of indebtedness of Wicomico County, which were issued against the levies for the years 1921, 1923, 1924, 1926 and 1927, by issuing vouchers to the Treasurer of Wicomico County and against the fund credited to said Commissioners.

SEC. 7. *And be it further enacted,* That for the purpose of paying the interest on said bonds and redeeming the said bonds as they may mature, the County Commissioners of Wicomico County shall levy for the year 1931 and annually thereafter until all of said bonds issued under the authority of this Act shall mature and be redeemed, a tax upon the assessable property of Wicomico County sufficient to pay the annual interest
