

2 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, (1930 Edition), title "Anne Arundel County", to be under a new sub-title "Destroying Property Maliciously", said new section to be known as Section 255A and to follow immediately after Section 255 of said Article, and to read as follows:

255A. Any person who shall, in Anne Arundel County, wilfully or maliciously damage or destroy any chair, counter, amusement device, game, vending machine or device, bench part or parts of buildings, sign, sea nettle guard net, fence, fixture, toilet facility or fixture, light, instrument, locker, table, mirror, screen, dining wear, drinking glasses, or other equipment belonging to or used by any bathing beach amusement park, tavern, dance saloon, bathhouse, or other place of public resort or amusement, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) or sentenced to imprisonment for not more than six months or both.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1941."

CHAPTER 685.

(House Bill 807)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 521-528, inclusive, of Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Allegany County", sub-title "Racing Commission."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Sections 521-528, inclusive, of Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Allegany County", sub-title "Racing Commission", be and they are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1941.

CHAPTER 686.

(House Bill 352)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 63 of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939
