

CLASS E. Commercial motor vehicles for hire with three axles and equipped with pneumatic tires, electrically operated, shall be divided into six classes based upon the gross shipping weight of the chassis and battery as given and certified to by the manufacturer, and the fee for each class shall be as follows:

SHIPPING WEIGHT OF CHASSIS AND BATTERY
IN POUNDS

CLASS	FEE
1 Less than 9000.....	\$80
2 9000 and over but less than 14000.....	\$120
3 14000 and over but less than 20000.....	\$160
4 20000 and over but less than 26000.....	\$240
5 26000 and over but less than 36000.....	\$320
6 36000 and over but less than 40000.....	\$400

Nothing in this section shall be construed to repeal or amend the law prescribing the fees to be paid by freight motor vehicles operating for hire with a permit from the Public Service Commission.

CLASS F. SOLID TIRES. For each motor vehicle equipped wholly or in part with solid tires propelled by other than internal combustion engines and having a rated carrying capacity of

not more than 2000 pounds.....	\$20

not more than 3000 pounds.....	\$15.00
not more than 4000 pounds.....	\$20.00
not more than 5000 pounds.....	\$25.00
not more than 6000 pounds.....	\$30.00
