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CHAPTER 381.

(Senate Bill 332)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 152 and 152A of Article 12 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Garrett County," sub-title "Dogs," relating to the licensing of dogs in Garrett County.

*Whereas*, the provisions of these sections have been superseded by the State-wide law and are no longer necessary; therefore

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 152 and 152A of Article 12 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Garrett County," sub-title "Dogs," be and they are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1943.

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CHAPTER 382.

(Senate Bill 335)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 175 to 178, inclusive, of Article 12 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Garrett County," sub-title "Fences," said Sections relating to fences in Garrett County and liability for certain injuries to cattle, and so forth.

*Whereas*, the provisions of these sections are no longer applicable or necessary; therefore

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Sections 175 to 178, inclusive, of Article 12
