Perkins Talbert's lot; thence with his South line North 73½° East 135 perches to a County (Livingston) Road; thence with said road South 7° East 13 perches; thence South 43° East 11 perches; thence South 76¾° East 21 perches to the East line of the whole tract; thence with said line South 2° West 94½ perches to place of beginning, containing 136-23/100 acres of land situated on the West side of Livingston Road in Oxon Hill District, Prince George's County, Maryland, being the same property conveyed to the Washington Heights Realty Corporation, and a part of which has been sub-divided and is known as "Forest Heights"; said property now adjoining on the North, the present outline of the Washington Suburban Sanitary District.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1943.

## CHAPTER 469.

(House Bill 557)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 281 of Article 5 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), as said section was amended by Chapter 337 of the Acts of 1933 and by Chapter 423 of the Acts of 1939, title "Calvert County", sub-title "Sheriff", increasing the sum payable to the Sheriff of Calvert County for keeping and boarding prisoners in the jail of said County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 281 of Article 5 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), as said section was amended by Chapter 337 of the Acts of 1933 and by Chapter 423 of the Acts of 1939, title "Calvert County", sub-title "Sheriff", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

281. The Sheriff of Calvert County shall receive a sum of money not to exceed seventy-five cents a day for keeping and boarding each prisoner in the county jail and shall also receive twenty-five dollars, for conveying to the State Penitentiary or to any other place of punishment situated beyond
