WHEREAS, the provisions of Section 496 of Article 3 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition) have been fully executed, and there is no further necessity for the authority contained in said section, therefore:

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 496 of Article 3 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Baltimore County", sub-title "Memorial", be and the same is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1943.

## CHAPTER 615.

(House Bill 675)

AN ACT to repeal Section 493 of Article 3 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Baltimore County", sub-title "Mechanics' Lien", providing for mechanics' liens for work done and materials provided on buildings erected or repaired.

WHEREAS, Section 493 of Article 3 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland duplicates the provisions of Section 1 of Article 63 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition) and is properly codified with the general laws of the State, rather than as a local law, therefore

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 493 of Article 3 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Baltimore County", sub-title "Mechanics' Lien", be and the same is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1943.
