

Boards of Health, and providing for compensation of County Health Officers.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 48 of Article 43 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Health", sub-title "Miscellaneous Provisions", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments to read as follows:

48. The Local Board of Health of each County shall meet semi-annually in the months of May and October, and as much oftener as they may deem necessary; they shall act in conjunction with the State Board of Health and shall report to said board such facts in reference to the sanitary conditions of their respective Counties as they may deem important or necessary; they may adopt and enforce all needful rules and regulations concerning nuisances and causes of sickness within their respective jurisdiction subject to the provisions of this Article; they may regulate all fees and charges in connection with their own regulations and shall establish the salaries of their respective county health officers on the following maximum bases: Not exceeding, in counties having a population of 15,000 or less, \$150 per annum, with an additional allowance of not more than \$100 per annum for each 8,000 of population in excess of 15,000.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1943.

CHAPTER 676.

(House Bill 787)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sub-section (a) of Section 262 of Article 23 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Wicomico County", sub-title "Salisbury", as said section was amended by Chapter 132 of the Acts of 1941, relating to the qualification of voters in the City of Salisbury.
