

CHAPTER 169.

(House Bill 40)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sections 75 and 76 of Article 39 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Fish and Fisheries", sub-title "Black Bass", relating to the period during which it shall be unlawful to catch, possess or transport black bass.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Sections 75 and 76 of Article 39 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Fish and Fisheries", sub-title "Black Bass", be and they are hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

75. It shall be unlawful to catch black bass in any manner in the tidal waters of the State of Maryland during the months of April, May and June in each and every year. It shall also be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to sell or offer to sell, purchase or offer to purchase or to have in possession any black bass during said months, whether said fish be caught in tidal or non-tidal waters within the State of Maryland, or the waters of any other State and brought into this State.

76. It shall be unlawful for any person to deliver to any private or common carrier for transportation, or for any private or common carrier to accept for transportation, or for any person to transport or carry or cause to be transported or carried by any means whatsoever, any black bass into or from the State of Maryland, during the months of April, May and June in each and every year.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1945.

CHAPTER 170.

(House Bill 42)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 533 and 534 of Article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland and Baltimore City Charter (1938 Edition), title "Baltimore City", sub-title
