

2. Deed from the Dundalk Company to the Trustees of the Church of God at Dundalk, dated November 13, 1931, and recorded among the Land Records of Baltimore County in Liber L. McL. M. No. 887, folio 430.

3. To the conveyance from St. John's Cemetery of Howard County, a body corporate, to the Vestry of St. John's Church, Queen Caroline Parish, Howard County, Maryland, a body corporate, of a parcel of land containing thirty-seven thousand nine hundred two and one-half square feet, or approximately eighty-seven one-hundredths of an acre, of land, more or less, situate in said Howard County, by deed dated the 30th day of August, 1943, and recorded among the Lands Records of said Howard County in Liber B.
