

Bureau. The said Statistical Bureau may charge a fee of fifty cents (50¢) to all persons other than an agency of the State or any sub-division thereof for furnishing a copy of the report relating to any accident and a fee of twenty-five cents (25¢) for searching its files and producing an accident report on application of any person wishing to make copy of same.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1945.

CHAPTER 33.

(House Bill 28)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sub-section (c) of Section 2 of Article 88B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "State Police", to correct an error in said sub-section.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Sub-section (c) of Section 2 of Article 88B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "State Police", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

2. (c) "Police Employees" shall mean any employee who is assigned to police work as a peace officer, pursuant to Section 21 of this Article.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1945.

CHAPTER 34.

(House Bill 36)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 6A of Article 21 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1943 Supplement), title "Conveyancing", sub-title "Conveyances in General", to eliminate the provision limiting acknowledgments by members of the armed forces of the United States before any commissioned officer to those located outside the continental limits of the United States.
