

CHAPTER 105.

(Senate Bill 151)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 140 and 141 of Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Allegany County," sub-title "Election Districts," authorizing the County Commissioners to increase the number of election districts in Allegany County.

WHEREAS, The Election Laws authorize the Supervisors of Elections to create new election districts, thereby rendering these sections unnecessary; therefore

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sections 140 and 141 of Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Allegany County," sub-title "Election Districts," be and they are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1945.

CHAPTER 106.

(Senate Bill 152)

AN ACT to repeal Section 150 of Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Allegany County," sub-title "Election Districts," relating to additional precincts in Election District Number 8.

WHEREAS, the provisions of this section are no longer necessary; therefore

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 150 of Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws (1930 Edition), title "Allegany County," sub-title "Election Districts," be and it is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1945.
