CHAPTER 124.

(Senate Bill 159)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 157 of Article 23 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Corporations," sub-title "Companies for the Erection of Bridges or Construction of Canals," relating to the construction of bridges over navigable rivers.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 157 of Article 23 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Corporations," sub-title "Companies for the Erection of Bridges or Construction of Canals," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

157. No bridge shall be erected on a navigable river, unless authorized by the State Roads Commission of Maryland.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1945.
