

“Motor Vehicle Financial Responsibility” to exempt owners and operators of motor vehicles operating under certificate or permit of the Interstate Commerce Commission who have blanket insurance filed with the Department of Motor Vehicles from the provisions of this section.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 107 (g) of Article 66½ of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title “Motor Vehicles”, sub-title “Motor Vehicle Financial Responsibility” be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

107. (g) This section shall not apply to the owners and operators of motor vehicles engaged in the transportation of passengers or property, subject to the jurisdiction of the Public Service Commission of Maryland, who operate 50 or more motor vehicles and have shown to the satisfaction of said Commission, during a continuous operation of at least five years duration, that they are financially qualified to respond in damages to at least the extent required of other motor vehicle operators by Sections 107 to 130, inclusive, of this Article, or to the owners and operators of motor vehicles operating under certificate or permit of the Interstate Commerce Commission who file blanket insurance with the Department of Motor Vehicles, the filing of which shall be construed as full compliance with this section.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1949.

## CHAPTER 638

(House Bill 712)
