

Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars nor more than One Thousand Dollars or by imprisonment for not less than thirty (30) days nor more than six (6) months, or both such fine and imprisonment.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1949.

CHAPTER 40

(Senate Bill 38)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 76 of Article 66½ of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Motor Vehicles", sub-title "Administration—Registration—Titling", relating to refunds of license fees.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 76 of Article 66½ of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Motor Vehicles", sub-title "Administration—Registration—Titling", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

76. (Refunds on Semi-Annual Basis.) Upon the surrender of the certificates and registration plates provided for in Classes A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I and J, and upon application made therefor, the original owner shall be entitled to refund of the amount paid for such certificates and registration plates for the unused portion of the registration year calculated on a semi-annual basis with no allowance for fractional portions of a half-year period; provided, however, that in the case of Class A, the refund shall be \$5.00 where the fee is \$15.00 and \$7.50 where the fee is \$23.00, and in the case of Class D the refund shall be \$1.50; provided further, that refund of the entire fee shall be allowed on unused license plates returned to the Department within thirty days after date of issuance, or returned prior to April 1st, where secured between February 15th and 29th preceding.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1949.
