And be it enacted, That the costs of sending cuting appeals: up the transcript of valuations on any appeal as aforesaid how defrayed shall be defraved by the respective counties, or by the city shall be defrayed by the respective counties, or by the city of Baltimore; and that all other costs incurred in the Court of Appeals, on said appeals, excepting legal or other fees to the attornies or counsel for the appellants on appeals taken by individuals, or for the appellees on any appeal taken by the State, shall be paid, upon the requisition of the Governor, out of any unappropiated money in the treasury.
