# RESOLUTIONS

AT THE EXTRA SESSION, A. D. 1841.

Resolution in favor of William S. Green, Clerk of Anne Arundel County. Passed Mar. 31, 1841.

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That all proceedings on the judgments obtained by the State of Maryland, against William S. Green, in Anne Arundel county court, be and they are hereby suspended; *provided,* the said William S. Green, shall, on the twelfth day of June next, pay and satisfy one-sixth of the said judgments; and one-sixth of the said judgments in every three months thereafter, until the whole is paid; *and provided also,* that upon a non-compliance with any one of the terms of this resolution, at the times therein specified, this resolution is hereby declared to be null and void; *and provided also,* that the said William S. Green, and his securities, shall file their assent to this resolution, on or before the first day of June next.
