RESOLUTIONS.

1841.

No. 15.

Resolution for the payment of subscription to newspapers for the use of the Members of the Legislature, by the chief clerk of the Senate and House of Delegates. Passed April 6, 1841.

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay to George G. Brewer, chief clerk to the House of Delegates, and Joseph H. Nicholson, chief clerk of the Senate, out of any unappropriated money in the treasury, the amount of the several accounts that may from time to time be presented to them, the said clerks, for newspapers furnished the members of the Legislature, during the sessions of December 1840, and March 1841; and that he also pay the amounts for postage upon letters forwarded and received by said clerks, relative to the duties of their respective offices.*

No. 16.

Resolution for the payment of one days per diem to the Members and Officers of the Legislature, to enable them to attend the funeral of the late President of the United States. Passed April 6, 1841.

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore, be and he is hereby directed to pay to the several members of the Legislature, and officers of the two house and the Secretary of State, respectively, the amount of one day's per diem, for expenses incurred in attending the funeral of the late President of the United States.*

Resolution in favor of John N. Stewart. Passed April 6, 1841.

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore, be directed to pay*
