CHAPTER 415.

An act to provide for the payment of the Journal of Ac- Passed April 6,

WHEREAS, it appears by the Journal of Accounts of Preamble
this session, that there is due from this State, the sum
of sixty-five thousand, seven hundred and fourteen
dollars and ninety-eight cents:—Therefore,

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Payment directed
That the Treasurer of the Western Shore be, and he
is hereby authorised and required to pay to the several
persons, their executors, administrators, assigns or
orders, or to such of them as shall offer to receive the
same, the several sums of money allowed to them re-
spectively, as they appear to be settled and ascertained
by the said journal of accounts, out of any money now
in the treasury, subject to appropriation by the Gene-
ral Assembly.
