CHAPTER 144.

Passed Jan. 27, 1840. *An act to authorise the Commissioners of Cecil County to levy a sum of money, to be appropriated to the erection of a Bridge over the North East Creek, at or near Johnson's Factory.*

Levy to be made SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the commissioners of Cecil county at their next annual levy, be and they are hereby authorised and empowered at their discretion, to levy a sum of moneynot to exceed four hundred dollars, on the assessable property of said county, for the purpose of building a bridge over the North East creek, at or near Johnson's factory.*

Commissioners to be appointed SEC. 2. *And be it enacted, That the commissioners of Cecil county shall appoint three commissioners to contract for or superintend the building of said bridge, who shall give bond and security to be approved by the aforesaid county commissioners.*

Account of expenses to be rendered SEC. 3. *And be it enacted, Than when the bridge aforesaid shall have been completed, a true and faithful account of all the cost and expenses shall be rendered to the county commissioners by the aforesaid bridge commissioners, or a majority of them, and then the county commissioners are hereby authorised to pay over to the said bridge commissioners or their order the above mentioned accounts; provided, they do not exceed the sum of four hundred dollars, including a reasonable compensation to the aforesaid bridge commissioners for their services.*
