*(d) The Chief of the Bureau of Revenue Estimates shall prepare and submit to the General Assembly, after the 20th day of each month, an itemized statement showing the following information:*

THE STATE COMPTROLLER CHIEF OF THE BUREAU OF REVENUE ESTIMATES, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE STATE COMPTROLLER'S OFFICE, SHALL PREPARE AND SUBMIT TO THE MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, BY THE END OF THE MONTHS OF JANUARY AND JULY IN EACH YEAR AN ITEMIZED STATEMENT SHOWING THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION FOR THE SIX-MONTH PERIOD ENDING ON THE NEXT PRECEDING DECEMBER 31 OR JUNE 30, AS THE CASE MAY BE:

(1) *estimated revenue from all sources, by funds, for the current budgetary period;*

(2) *collections for the current month and months to date NEXT PRECEDING SIX-MONTH PERIOD; and*

(3) *amount of revenue uncollected or over-collected.*

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1952.

## CHAPTER 40

(Senate Bill 87)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Subsection (4) (b) of Section 8, of Article 73B of the Annotated Code of Maryland - 1951 Edition, said Section being Section 7 in the 1939 Edition - title "Pensions," sub-title "Allowance on ordinary Disability Retirement," to adjust the benefits allowed State employees retired on disability.
