## CHAPTER 65

(House Bill 115)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 3 of Chapter 476 of the Acts of 1951, said Act enacting a new Article 31A of the Annotated Code of Maryland under the title "Defective Delinquents", providing for the establishment of the Patuxent Institution for Defective Delinquents and relating generally to the detention and care of defective delinquents, changing the effective date of the said Chapter 476.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 3 of Chapter 476 of the Acts of 1951 be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

3. This Act shall take effect on June 1, [1952] 1954, except that the Chief Psychiatrist and the two associate psychiatrists of the Department of Correction shall be appointed as soon as possible after July 1 [1951] 1952, at the salaries provided for hereinabove in this Act.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect on June 1, 1952.
