

CHAPTER 66

(Senate Bill 10)

AN ACT to repeal Section 33 of Article 17 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition—being Section 28 in the 1939 Edition), title “Clerks of Courts,” sub-title “Docket and Docket Entries,” said section requiring the clerks of courts to transcribe certain docket entries in separate books after each term.

WHEREAS, the rules of the Court of Appeals provide that the several clerks of courts shall keep substantial dockets and make docket entries to show the real condition and progress of proceedings, hereby making it unnecessary to transcribe and keep separate dockets, as required by Section 33; and

WHEREAS, a majority of the clerks do not at the present time keep such dockets; now therefore

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland.* That Section 33 of Article 17 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition—being Section 28 in the 1939 Edition), title “Clerks of Courts”, sub-title “Docket and Docket Entries,” be and it is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1952.

CHAPTER 67

(Senate Bill 14)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 82 of Article 66½ of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition—being Section 75 in the 1947 Supplement), title “Motor Vehicles,” sub-title “Administration—Registration—Titling,” relating to the annual registration fee for motor vehicles for periods less than twelve months in length.
