SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 234 of Article 18 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Queen Anne's County," sub-title "Foxes," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

234. It shall not be lawful to kill or injure any fox in Queen Anne's County, when pursued by dogs *or to shoot or shoot at any dog while pursuing a fox in Queen Anne's County.*

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1951.

## CHAPTER 54

(Senate Bill 83)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 145 (c) Kent County. (1) of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Alcoholic Beverages," sub-title "County Dispensaries," increasing the reserve and inventory of the Kent County dispensary.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 145 (c) Kent County. (1) of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Alcoholic Beverages," sub-title "County Dispensaries," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

(c) Kent County. (1) All net profits arising from the operation of said dispensaries and branch dispensaries, as aforesaid, shall be first applied toward payment of any
