

wood Brothers, Inc., by deed dated April 20, 1948 and of record among the Land Records of Caroline County in Liber No. 111 Folio 73, together with all improvements thereon and all rights and appurtenances thereto belonging, unto Caroline County Health Association, Inc., a Maryland corporation, its successors and assigns, OR TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CAROLINE COUNTY.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency law and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, and the same being passed by a yea and nay vote, supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, shall take effect upon the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 557

(House Bill 205)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 87 of Article 48A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Insurance", sub-title "Agents and Brokers", to permit persons authorized by general or per policy power of attorney to sign or countersign policies of insurance in addition to officers or agents of the insurer.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 87 of Article 48A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Insurance", sub-title "Agents and Brokers", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

87. (Resident Agent.) No company authorized to transact business in this State, and no person, resident or non-resident, shall write any policy of insurance, or assume any liability in the matter of insurance upon any property, real or personal, situated in this State, unless such policy, certificate or other evidence of liability assumed by said company or person shall
