

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 132 of Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Charles County", sub-title "Indian Head," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

132. The said Town Commissioners shall, in the month of June, in the year 1920, and the same month each and every year thereafter, if they deem it advisable, cause an assessment to be made of all real and personal property within said town of Indian Head, or the corporate limits thereof, by their clerk, which assessment shall not exceed the assessment of the same for the county purposes, if the same be assessed for county purposes, and the said Town Commissioners may levy a tax thereon not exceeding [twenty-five] *fifty* cents on the hundred dollars' worth of assessable property.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1951.

CHAPTER 259

(House Bill 530)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 23 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Prince George's County (1943 Edition), being Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Prince George's County", sub-title "Berwyn Heights", amending the Charter of Berwyn Heights to provide for the election of a Chairman of the Board of Commissioners and to authorize the payment of a certain sum to each Commissioner to help defray expenses, and providing for a referendum thereon.
