

for a second time as to the same person shall immediately thereafter file charges for his permanent removal from the classified service, acting generally pursuant to the provisions of Section 29 of this Article, with further proceedings to be had thereunder.

(C) ANY PERSON WHO IS DENIED AN INCREASE IN SALARY UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPH (2) OF SUB-SECTION (B) HEREINABOVE SHALL HAVE A RIGHT OF APPEAL TO THE COMMISSIONER, WHO SHALL HAVE THE POWER TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE SUSPENSION AND RESULTING DENIAL OF AN INCREASE WERE JUSTIFIED AND THE FURTHER POWER TO CHANGE OR MODIFY THE SUSPENSION AND THE DENIAL OF AN INCREASE ACCORDING TO SUCH DETERMINATION.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1954.

(House Bill 147)
