SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 30 (c) of Article 66½ of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Motor Vehicles", sub-title "Administration—Registration—Titling", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:*

30.

(c) During any period of *National or other* emergency, *by reason of a shortage of materials or for other cause*, the Department may with the approval of the Governor adopt and issue such other means of registration and identification as the Department may deem sufficient. The Department may, with the approval of the Governor, adopt a permanent registration system and design and adopt permanent registration plates in such form as to make effective such system. *It is the legislative intent that sub-section (a) of this section should be generally adhered to as the policy of the State in the issuance of motor vehicle registration plates.*

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1954.*
