

## CHAPTER 577

(House Bill 894)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sub-section (h) of Section 40 of Article 10 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Attorneys at Law and Attorneys in Fact", sub-title "State's Attorney", relating to the compensation of the Assistant State's Attorney for Allegany County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Sub-section (h) of Section 40 of Article 10 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Attorneys at Law and Attorneys in Fact", sub-title "State's Attorney", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

40.

(h) The State's Attorney of Allegany County shall receive an annual salary of not less than \$4,000 nor more than \$4,800, in the discretion of the County Commissioners of said county. The Assistant State's Attorney of Allegany County shall receive an annual salary of *not less than* \$3,000.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.

## CHAPTER 578

(House Bill 895)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sub-sections (f) and (g-a) of Section 40 of Article 10 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Attorneys at Law and Attorneys in Fact", sub-title "State's Attorney", relating to the annual compensation of the State's Attorney of Wicomico County.
