

CHAPTER 29

(Senate Bill 63)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 7 to 34, inclusive, of Article 8 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Cecil County", sub-title "Almshouse."

WHEREAS, the provisions of Sections 7 to 34, inclusive, of the Public Local Laws of Cecil County are now obsolete and should be repealed; now therefore

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sections 7 to 34, inclusive, of Article 8 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Cecil County", sub-title "Almshouse", be and they are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.

CHAPTER 30

(Senate Bill 64)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 60 of Article 8 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Cecil County", sub-title "Cecilton", said section having been amended by Chapter 7 of the Acts of 1937, removing from said section certain material applicable to the year 1937 and now obsolete.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 60 of Article 8 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Cecil County", sub-title "Cecilton", said section having been amended by Chapter 7 of the Acts of 1937, be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:
