CITY OF BALTIMORE—The governor to appoint five commissioners, three to reside west and two east of Jones's Falls, to divide into twenty wards, &c.

Commissioners to locate twelve wards west and eight east of said Falls, and make returns, &c. one to the Register of city, the other to clerk of Baltimore county, &c. Register to cause said return to be published, &c.

Mode of electing members of City Council prescribed, &c.

The first fifteen wards to constitute fourth Congressional district, remaining five wards, Baltimore county, Howard District and Carroll county, the third Congressional district, &c.

Compensation of commissioners fixed, Mayor and City Council to provide for the payment, &c.

When the president for First or second Branch, &c. shall ex officio become mayor by virtue of second section of act of 1832, ch. 206, he shall within five days after he shall so succeed give notice for an election of mayor, &c. notice to be 15 days instead of 20, &c.

Term of office of mayor to commence on second Monday November succeeding his election.

All laws and ordinances relating to elections in the city applicable to present division of wards to be applicable to division in twenty wards, &c.

Elections hereafter to be held for mayor, &c. on 2nd Wednesday instead of 3rd Monday of October, &c.
