

CHAP. 158. *SEC. 6. And be it enacted,* That the said commissioners, before they proceed to act, shall take an oath or affirmation, before some justice of the peace, that they will without favor, partiality or prejudice, assess the damages sustained by the persons through whose lands the said road may pass.

SEC. 7. And be it enacted, That after the said road shall be surveyed and located, the opening thereof shall be superintended in each county respectively, by the commissioners, or a majority of them so appointed.

Superintending road.

Passed Feb. 14, 1846. *An act to allow Selman Cox, late collector of Baltimore County, further time to complete his collections.*

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the time limited by law within which Selman Cox, late collector of Baltimore county, should have made his collections be, and the same is hereby extended to the first day of April, eighteen hundred and forty seven; *provided,* that the said Cox shall comply with the provisions of the first section of the act passed at December session, eighteen hundred and forty three, chapter ninety-six.

Passed Feb. 16, 1846. *An act to alter and change the line between School Districts Number Four and Seven, in the Upper Election District in Caroline County.*

Preamble. *WHEREAS,* it has been represented to this General Assembly, that by the remoteness of Jeremiah Rust's residence from the school house in school district number seven in Caroline county, within the lines of which school district, his farm and premises are embraced, is such as to deprive him of the benefit of said school, whilst at the same time his residence is within one mile of the school house at Greensborough, in school district number four—therefore,
