Preamble and Resolution for the Relief of certain Arms Makers in the State of Virginia

WHEREAS it appears from the report of the Adjutant General of Maryland made in obedience to the orders of the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Militia of the State of Maryland that there are a number of arms in the several States of Maryland which may be rendered serviceable in a small degree and thereby enable the owners to apply to a considerable extent the numerous regulations for arms from the United States of arms rendered serviceable from the General Government for the State's use under the act of Congress of eighteen hundred and

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland That the Governor be and he is hereby authorized to contract for the repairs of said arms and such other as may from time to time be referred to said Assembly upon the most reasonable terms and that he draw on the Treasurer for such sum or sums as may be necessary for the cost and expense thereof in favor of the person or persons performing such service
