Resolution for the publication of the Revenue Laws.

March 8, 1847.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the treasurer be and he is hereby authorised and directed to cause to be published in two papers printed in the city of Baltimore, and one German paper, and one paper in Howard district, and in each county where a newspaper is printed, such acts passed by the General Assembly as provide for the general revenue of the State, and the said treasurer be authorised to pay for said publication out of any unappropriated money in the treasury.

No. 64.

Resolution in favor of George Kennedy.

March 8, 1847.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the State be and he hereby is authorised and required to pay to George Kennedy, the sum of fifty-three dollars and fifteen cents, for services rendered and expenses incurred in bringing into this State, under a requisition of the Governor, a fugitive from justice.
