Feb. 14, 1848. *An act for the relief of Charles Crawford, a free man of color.*

visit this State. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Charles Crawford, a free man of color, now residing in the District of Columbia, be and he is hereby permitted to come into this State for the purpose of visiting his wife, the slave of Eleanor B. M. Hilleary, of Prince George's county; *provided*, the said Charles Crawford shall give bond and security in the sum of fifty dollars, to be filed in the office of the clerk of Prince George's county court, for his good behavior in said county, recoverable in the name of the State, before the county court of said county; *and provided further*, that the said Charles Crawford shall not come into this State for the purpose of employment, and remain longer at any one time than four days, unless detained by sickness.
