CHAP. 48. and forfeitures made payable by said act, and the supplements thereto.

Inconsistent acts repealed. SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That all the provisions of the act to which this is a supplement, and of the various supplements thereto, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this act, be and the same are hereby repealed.

In force. SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from its passage.

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CHAPTER 47.

Passed Jan. 30, 1850. *An act to authorise the Levy Court of Frederick County, in their discretion, to levy a sum of money to build a Bridge over Catoctin Creek, on the Public Road leading from Fredericktown, in said county, to Greencastle, Pennsylvania.*

Levy authorised. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the judges of the levy court of Frederick county, be and they are hereby authorised and empowered, in their discretion, to levy a sum of money, not exceeding six hundred dollars, on the assessable property in said county, to be paid in two annual instalments, of three hundred dollars each, for the purpose of building a bridge over Catoctin creek, on the public road leading from Fredericktown, in said county, to Greencastle, Pennsylvania.

To contract SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the levy court aforesaid, be and the same is hereby authorised to contract with any person or persons to build said bridge, and are required to take bond or bonds, with sufficient security, from any contractor or contractors, for the faithful performance of his or their contracts, in the usual form.
