

*An act supplementary to an act passed at December session, eighteen hundred and forty-two, chapter two hundred and fourteen.* Passed Feb. 4 1850.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That all applications for insurance in the Mutual Fire Insurance Company in Harford county, shall be made in writing, and signed by the party or parties making such application, and that such signature shall be deemed as full an assent to the charter, constitution, and bye-laws, of said company, as if made according to the requirements of the second section of the act to which this act is a supplement. <sup>Proxies authorized.</sup>

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That it may and shall be lawful for any married woman, with the assent of her husband, signified by his signature to the application for insurance, to apply for, and have insurance in said company, on the property of said married woman, and that the premium note given by such married woman and her husband, shall be a lien upon the real estate so insured, and shall be as binding and effectual upon such married woman, as if she were sole and unmarried. <sup>Married women may insure.</sup>

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That at the next annual election, and every annual election thereafter, of directors of said company, it shall and may be lawful for the said company to elect, in manner provided by their charter, three directors for Baltimore county, in addition to those already authorized by the original act to which this is a supplement, and that at such election, and at all meetings of the stockholders or members of said company, each member or person insured shall have one vote, and may be present and vote in person or by proxy. <sup>Additional directors.</sup>

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall be in force and take effect as soon as the same shall be accepted and assented to by the said company, as part of their charter, and that the Legislature reserves to itself the right, at any time, to change, alter or annul this act. <sup>Reservation.</sup>
