No. 71.

Passed Mar. 8, 1850. Resolution in favor of the representatives of Elizabeth Stuart.

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland,*  
That the Treasurer be and he is hereby authorised and required to pay to Woolman I. Gibson, for the use of the representatives of Elizabeth Stuart, deceased, the sum of thirty-three dollars and thirty-three cents, being the amount due said Elizabeth Stuart, for pension, per resolution number twenty-three, of eighteen hundred and forty-three, to the twenty-first day of February, eighteen hundred and forty-nine, the day of her death.

Passed Mar. 8, 1850. Resolution for the payment of the Index to the Public Documents for the present Session.

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland,*  
That the Treasurer of the State pay to George G. Brewer, Chief Clerk of the present House of Delegates, the sum of seventy-five dollars, for making out an Index to the Public Documents of the present Session, as directed by resolution of December Session, eighteen hundred and forty-four.

Passed Mar. 8, 1850. Resolution in favor of Mrs. Cornelia Lansdale, the widow of Major Lansdale.

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland,*  
That the Treasurer of Maryland pay to Cornelia Lansdale, widow of Thomas Lausdale, a Major in the fourth Maryland Regiment, in the war of the Revolution, the half pay of a Major, for the balance of her
