And he doth enact, That any person who shall be guilty of any offence against the laws of this State, shall be liable to be arrested by any peace officer, or by any private person, at any time and place, and shall be taken to the nearest jail, or to the county jail, in the county or city, where such offence was committed, and there to be confined until he shall be discharged by a court of competent jurisdiction, and until such imprisonment in the jail or county jail, or in the city or town jail, shall not exceed a term of not more than three months, or shall not exceed a sum of not more than one hundred dollars in the discretion of the court.
