

49. An act entitled, an act to repeal an act passed at December session 1849, chapter 540, entitled, an act to provide for taking the sense of the people of Baltimore county on the propriety of separating said county from the city of Baltimore.

50. An act entitled, an act to regulate the return of process to the first terms of the Circuit courts within the sixth judicial circuit of this State.

51. An act entitled, an act to regulate the holding of the terms of Circuit courts within the sixth judicial circuit.

52. An act entitled, an act to change the time of electing representatives of this State in the Congress of the United States.

53. An act entitled, an act appropriating the sum of two thousand dollars to meet the deficiencies of the contingent fund for the year 1851.

54. An act entitled, an act to authorise the commissioners of Prince George's county to levy a sum of money sufficient to repair and furnish the court house of said county.

55. An act entitled, an act to provide for publishing reports of cases argued and determined by the Court of Appeals.

56. An act entitled, an act to prescribe the duties of the Comptroller.

57. An act entitled, an act to protect the growth of oysters in Worcester county.

58. An act entitled, an act to make valid a deed from Ann Jenkins, Denton Miller and Margaret Ann, his wife, and James P. Jenkins, of Howard District of Anne Arundel county, in the State of Maryland, to Eliza Ellen O'Neal, of the same District and State.

59. An act entitled, an act to carry into effect the 10th section of the 7th article of the Constitution, so far as relates to the surveyor of the city of Baltimore.

60. An act entitled, an act to provide for running and marking that portion of the boundary line between the States of Maryland and Virginia, extending from Smith's Point, at the mouth of the Potomac river, to the Atlantic Ocean.

61. An act entitled, an act to empower the board of commissioners of Washington county to lay off a new election district in said county, to be composed of a part of election districts number one and number eight in said county, and the polls to be held at Sandy Hook.

62. An act entitled, an act to distribute the unfinished business of the late Orphans' court of Baltimore county.

63. An act entitled, an act for the amendment of the law in criminal cases.

64. An act to authorise the sale of certain real estate in Dorchester county, purchased heretofore by Benjamin Jenifer, and conveyed to his wife Hester Ann Jenifer, for life, with remainder to the children of the said Benjamin.

65. An act to substitute the Treasurer of this State in the place of the late Commissioner of Loans, in relation to the renewal of certain certificates of stock.
