thereof, authorizing the appropriate authorities of any incorporated city, town or village to regulate the speed of vehicles on any road, street, lane or alley within the corporate limits thereof which has not been designated or maintained as a part of the State or Federal highway system or an extension thereof.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That a new section be and it is hereby added to Article 66½ of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Motor Vehicles", sub-title "Operation of Vehicles Upon Highways", said new section to be known as Section 151A, to follow immediately after Section 151 thereof, and to read as follows:

151A. (Powers of Cities, Towns and Villages.) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Article, the appropriate authorities of any incorporated city, town or village are authorized and empowered to regulate the speed of vehicles on any road, street, lane or alley which is within their respective corporate limits and which has not been designated or maintained as a part of the State or Federal highway system or an extension thereof.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency law and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, and having been passed by a yea and nay vote, supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly of Maryland, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 44

(Senate Bill 8)

AN ACT to add Sections 16 to 36, inclusive, to Article 89 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Department of Labor and Industry," said new sections to follow immediately after Section 15 thereof and to be under the new sub-title "Occupational Health and Safety"; to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 478 of Article 66C of said Code, title "Natural Resources", sub-title "Mining"; to add Section 165A to Article 48 of said Code, title "Inspections," sub-title "Boiler Rules," to follow immediately after Section 165 thereof; to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 169 of said Article 48, title "Inspections," sub-title "Boiler Rules;" to add Section 68A to Article 101 of said Code, title "Workmen's Compensation," said new section to follow immediately after Section 68 thereof, and to be under the sub-title "Miscellaneous," creating a Division of Industrial Safety within the Department of Labor and Industry, under the direction of a Director of Industrial Safety, relating generally to the occupational
